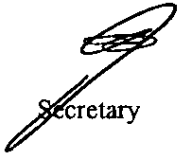
FIXED ASSETS

**REPORT OF THE INDEPENDENT EXAMINERS TO THE TRUSTEES

We have examined the financial statements on pages 4 to 8 for the year ended 31st March 2009 which have been prepared under the accounting policies set out on page 6.

Respective responsibilities of the trustees and examiner

As the charity's trustees, you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts; you consider that the audit requirements of Section 43 (2) of the Charities Act 1993 (the Act) does not apply, and that an independent examination is needed. It is our responsibility to examine the accounts under section 43(3)(a) of the Act and to state, on the basis of procedures specified in the General Directions Charity Commissioners under Section 43(7)(b) of the Act, whether particular matters have come to our attention.

Basis of independent examiner's report

Our examination was carried out in accordance with the General Directions given by the Charity Commissioners. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and consequently we do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

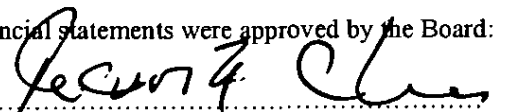

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Basis of preparation of financial statements

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Companies Act 1985 and Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting and Reporting by Charities issued in March 2005.

(b) Income

Grant is recorded on the accrual basis whilst donations and fundraising activities income are recorded on the cash basis.

(c) Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated on the straight line basis at the rate of 20% per annum that is estimated to write off the assets over their expected useful lives.

(d) Fund Accounting

Grants and similar income which are subject to donor imposed restrictions as to their use and related expenditure are accounted for as restricted funds. All other income and expenditure are accounted for as unrestricted.

(e) Resource Expended

Direct charitable expenditure comprises expenses that are directly related to the furtherance of the organisation's charitable activities. All other expenses are shown under governance costs
