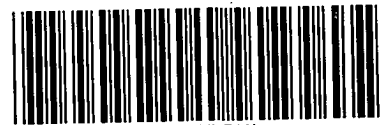



**Basis of preparation**

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

**Going concern**

The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis. The parent company has confirmed its continuing support of the business.

**Depreciation**

Depreciation is provided on tangible fixed assets so as to write off the cost, less any estimated residual value, over their expected useful economic life as follows:
