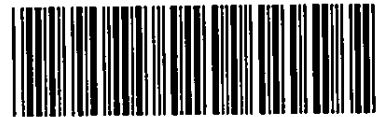

1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008)

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life

Plant and machinery etc	- 20 and 25% on reducing balance
Computer equipment	25% on straight line basis

Stocks

Stocks and work in progress are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items

Cost includes all direct expenditure and an appropriate proportion of fixed and variable overheads

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date

Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to the profit and loss account on a straight line basis over the period of the lease

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme Contributions payable to the company's pension scheme are charged to the profit and loss account in the period to which they relate

During the year the company purchased goods and services from G-Tech Building Services Ltd to the value of £14,411, and supplied goods and services to G-Tech amounting to £2,012. These transactions were on a normal trading basis. The Directors of Jackson Lewis Controls hold a material interest in the shares of G-Tech.

At the end of the year the company was in receipt of a loan from the company's self administered pension fund of £10,559 (31/03/12 £Nil). The annual rent payable to the company's pension fund is £36,000.
