Statement of Directors' Responsibilities


The directors are responsible for preparing the Directors' Report and the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and regulations



5 Parent undertakings

The company's immediate parent undertaking is Harrods (UK) Limited. The ultimate United Kingdom parent undertaking of Harrods (UK) Limited is Harrods Group (Holding) Limited, a company registered in England and Wales. The largest and smallest group of undertakings for which group accounts have been drawn up is that headed by Harrods Group (Holding) Limited. The group accounts will be filed with the Registrar of Companies in due course.

The company is an indirect 100% subsidiary of Qatar Holding LLC, which is the strategic investment arm of Qatar Investment Authority, the ultimate controlling party.

The company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Harrods Group (Holding) Limited and, as permitted by Financial Reporting Standard 8 "Related Party Disclosures", transactions with other entities in the Harrods Group (Holding) are not disclosed.
