

ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION of GARY CORBETT AND DARREN TERENCE
BROOKES by application notice dated

AND UPON reading the documents recorded upon the court file as having been read

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. For the purposes of this application the liquidations and administrations, details of which are set out in the schedule annexed to this order, which are proceeding in any court other than this court, be transferred to this court for the purposes only of this order and thereafter be transferred back to their original court.

2. In relation to all the appointments as liquidator of the creditors' voluntary liquidations, the details of which are set out in part 1 of the schedule annexed hereto, the First Applicant shall be removed and replaced by the appointment of the First Respondent with effect from the date of this order.
3. In relation to the appointments as liquidator of the compulsory liquidations, the details of which are set out in part 2 of the schedule annexed hereto, the First Applicant shall be removed and replaced by the appointment of the First Respondent with effect from the date of this order.
4. In relation to the appointment as administrator the details of which are set out in part 3 of the schedule annexed hereto, the First Applicant shall be removed and replaced by the appointment of the First Respondent with effect from the date of this order.
5. For the purpose of rule 12.38(6)(b) of the Insolvency (England & Wales) Rules 2016 ("the Rules") the Applicant appointed in substitution for the First Respondent is directed to:
 - (a). give notice to creditors of this order in the next progress report sent pursuant to rules 18.7(6), 18.8(5) and 18.6(4) of the Rules to the creditors of companies in creditors' voluntary liquidation, of companies being wound up by the Court and of those in administration, respectively;
 - (b). advertise this order by placing a notice in the form of the draft notice contained in the schedule to the second witness statement of the Second Applicant in the London Gazette within 3 months of this order.
6. The notice referred to in paragraph 5(b) of this order shall stand as the advertisements and notices required to be gazetted, advertised and given for the purposes of section 109 and paragraph 46 of Schedule B1 of the Act and rules 6.23, 7.59 and 3.27 of the Rules.
7. There be liberty to each creditor in the various insolvency proceedings to apply to vary or discharge this order, insofar as it relates to the particular insolvency proceeding in which that person is a creditor, within 28 days following the appearance in the London Gazette of the advertisement referred to in paragraph 5(b) of this order.
8. The First Applicant shall be removed as a signatory on the estate bank account for each case listed and particularised in the second schedule to the witness statement of the First Applicant and shall be replaced as signatory by the First Respondent appointed in substitution for him.
9. The costs of and incidental to this application be summarily assessed at £1,730.80 (inclusive of VAT and disbursements) such costs to be apportioned equally between the insolvency proceedings and shall be paid as an expense of such cases provided that in any case the part apportioned to that case shall not exceed 10% of the value of the realised assets of that case.
