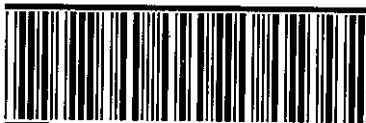

AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE DIRECTORS OF

AXLEBOND LIMITED

PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH 24 OF SCHEDULE 8 TO THE COMPANIES ACT, 1985

We have examined the abbreviated financial statements on pages 3 to 5 together with the full financial statements of Axlebond Limited for the year ended 31st March, 1995. The scope of our work for the purpose of this report was limited to confirming that the company is entitled to the exemptions claimed in the directors' statement on page 3 and that the abbreviated financial statements have been properly prepared from the full financial statements.

In our opinion, the company is entitled under sections 246 and 247 of the Companies Act, 1985 to the exemptions conferred by section A of part III of schedule 8 to that Act in respect of the year ended 31st March, 1995 and the abbreviated financial statements on pages 3 to 5 have been properly prepared in accordance with that schedule.

On 21st July, 1995, we reported, as auditors of Axlebond Limited, to the members on the full financial statements prepared under section 226 of the Companies Act, 1985 for the year ended 31st March, 1995 and our audit report was as follows:

"We have audited the financial statements on pages 5 to 10 which have been prepared under the accounting policies set out on page 7.

Respective Responsibilities of Directors and Auditors

As described on page 3, the company's directors are responsible for the preparation of financial statements. It is our responsibility to form an independent opinion, based on our audit, on those statements and to report our opinion to you.

Basis of Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Auditing Standards issued by the Auditing Practices Board. An audit includes examination, on a test basis, of evidence relevant to the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. It also includes an assessment of the significant estimates and judgements made by the directors in the preparation of the financial statements, and of whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the company's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

We planned and performed our audit so as to obtain all the information and explanations which we considered necessary in order to provide us with sufficient evidence to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or error or other irregularity. In forming our opinion, we also evaluated the overall adequacy of the presentation of information in the financial statements.





1. Accounting Policies

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost accounting rules.

The company has taken advantage of the exemption from preparing a cash flow statement conferred by Financial Reporting Standard Number 1 on the grounds that it is entitled to the exemptions available in sections 246 to 247 of the Companies Act, 1985 for small companies.

Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on the tangible fixed assets shown below at rates calculated to write off the cost, less estimated residual value, of each asset evenly over its expected useful life as follows:
