

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH APRIL 2005

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1.1. Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention.

The company has taken advantage of the exemption in FRS1 from the requirement to produce a cashflow statement because it is a small company.

1.2. Turnover

Turnover represents the total invoice value, excluding value added tax, of sales made during the year.

1.3. Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

Fixtures, fittings and equipment	- 15% reducing balance
Motor vehicles	- 25% reducing balance

The directors consider that freehold properties are maintained in such a state of repair that their residual value is at least equal to their net book value. As a result the corresponding depreciation would not be material and therefore is not charged in the profit and loss account. The directors perform annual impairment reviews in accordance with the requirements of FRS 15 and FRS 11 to ensure that the recoverable amount is not lower than the carrying value.

1.4. Deferred taxation

Provision is made for deferred taxation using the liability method, to take account of timing differences between the incidence of income and expenditure for taxation and accounting purposes, except to the extent that the directors consider that a liability to taxation is unlikely to materialise.

2. TURNOVER

The total turnover of the company for the year has been derived from its principal activity wholly undertaken in the UK.
