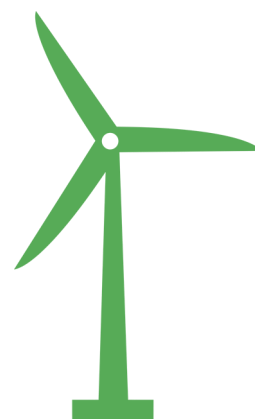

### Wind Turbine

#### Level 2

To gain the Wind Turbine award you need to carry out and evidence the following actions:

#### Pupils

All classes within the school should explore energy and sustainability in two additional curriculum areas.

Have at least one eco-group meeting every half-term.

The eco-group should plan and deliver a whole school assembly.

#### Staff

All staff should attend a meeting or session on energy saving behaviors and create an associated plan of action.

#### Whole School & Wider Community

In partnership with the PTA, run one whole school community event based around one of the global goals. Use the money raised to invest in energy efficiency.

#### Energy Efficiency Actions

Ask your ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools Officer to deliver an in-school session.

## Wind Turbine

Level 2

To gain the Wind Turbine award you need to carry out and evidence the following actions:

### Pupil

**All classes within the school should explore energy and sustainability in two additional curriculum areas**

The educational resources on the ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools Website can help you plan and deliver engaging learning experiences in different curriculum areas, centered around energy and sustainability.

⇒ **Required Evidence:** Two lesson plans from each class.

### Have at least one eco-group meeting every half-term

In ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Savings Resources you can find lots of eco-group resources to help you plan and deliver eco-group meetings, such as a minutes sheet. Your ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools Officer can also help you deliver some eco-group meetings.

⇒ **Required Evidence:** Minutes from each eco-group meeting that has taken place.

### The eco-group should plan and deliver a whole school assembly

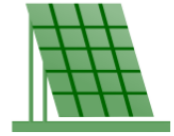
You can find an eco-group assembly script in the eco-group resource pack. This pack can be found in ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Savings Resources.

⇒ **Required Evidence:** A plan for the assembly.

## Staff

**All staff should attend a meeting or sessions on energy saving behaviors and created an associated plan of action**

In 'ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Environment Resources' you can find a range of resources, such as presentations and quizzes, to help you educate your staff on energy saving behaviors and why it is important to save energy. Your ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools Officer can also come in and deliver a staff twilight session or meeting. The associated plan of action should detail energy saving actions that staff will practice e.g. switching off the projector when not in use.

⇒ **Required Evidence:** A plan for the staff session and a scanned copy of the associated plan of action.

## Whole School and Wider Community

**In partnership with the PTA, run one whole school community event based around one of the global goals. Use the money raised to invest in energy efficiency.**

In 2015, world leaders agreed to 17 global goals for a better world by 2030, such as climate action and life below water. The global goals are uploaded on the ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools Award page, along with some ideas of whole school community events, based around these goals, that you could run.

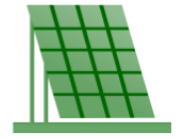
Your most recent energy progress report, sent to you by your ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools Officer, details ways in which your school could become more energy efficient. If you would like some more guidance in investing your money in energy efficiency, please contact your ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools officer.

⇒ **Required Evidence:** An event plan and a short paragraph about what the raised money will be invested in to improve energy efficiency.

## Energy Efficiency

**Ask your ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools Officer to deliver an in-school session**

Your ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools Officer can deliver educational assemblies and whole class/eco-group/school council sessions across the curriculum, centered around energy and sustainability.

⇒ **Required Evidence:** Confirmation from your ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools Officer that they have been in and delivered at least one in-school session.

**All evidence should be sent to your ECO<sub>2</sub> Smart Schools Officer who will monitor your progress and support throughout the award.**

Upon completion of Level 2: Wind Turbine Award your school will receive a certificate which recognises that you are a school committed to energy efficiency and sustainability.
