Yamaha YZF R6 Tail Tidy Installation Instructions

Fits Years - 2006 - Onwards

Kit contents

1 x small sealing plate	2 x Number Plate Screws & Nuts
1 x reflector	4 x M6x30mm black screws
1 x reflector Bracket	4 x M6 washers (black)
2 x male bullet connectors	5 x 6mm flange nuts
2 x M4 x 12mm c/sunk screws	5 x cable ties

4 x 6mm flange nuts

Fitting Instructions

1. Remove the rear seat/cowl.
2. Undo the four screws that hold the original fender in position.
3. Unplug the wires for the indicators and number plate light.
4. Attach the number plate holder and the number plate holder support together using the 2 M4 CSK screws supplied.
5. Release the indicators and fit them to the new tail tidy. If the plastic inserts are hard to fit into the rubber – smear a little washing up liquid around them. Fit the LED to the tail tidy using the M6 flange nut.
6. Push the wires through the hole in the machined sealing plate.
7. Push the wires back through the hole in the under tray and plug them back in. Connect the new LED number plate wires:
Black-Black and Red – Red/Blue.
8. Bolt the new tail tidy in place.
9. Refit the seat/cowl.
10. Check all of the electrics work correctly.

For 2008/10Model, although the Tail tidy is the same, the fitting routine is slightly different;

1. Remove the front and rear seats
2. Remove the whole rear cowl panel - 4 screws underneath (2 each side), and a series of “push centre” plugs. As the name suggests, push in centre then pull whole plug out - 4 on top, one at the front on each side front.
3. Flex the panel and remove, being careful of any lugs/tags.
4. Remove the large curved plate across the sub-frame - 8 screws.
5. The tail tidy is fixed beneath the tool tray, so this needs to be lifted to gain access to the bolts. Remove the seat lock bar, 2 bolts and 1 ”R” Clip. Move to side. *Check position of return spring and note before removing. There is also a small plastic support spacer under the bracket on the left side- DO NOT LOSE IT!*
6. Unclip the wires along l/h side of tool tray, spring the clips on the large black box (ICU) and lift the box out without disconnecting the wires.
7. Disconnect the two rear indicator plugs and the two bullet terminals from the number plate light. Remove the 3 plastic cross head clips from the under-tray. These strictly speaking are not screw fixings, but unscrew centre while lifting centre out with fingers and remove whole clip.
8. Lift up tool tray to gain access to the four bolts and remove them, lift away original rear light assembly.
9. Assemble Evotech Tail Tidy, small plate is to help seal wire entry to bike, Fix to bike using 4x screws/washers from underneath, nuts at top. Reconnect indicators, connect number plate light using bullet connectors supplied. Check lights all work correctly.
10. Reverse steps 1-8 to reassemble. *Push the centres of plastic plugs back out before inserting into bodywork, then push centres flush again to secure.*
