

## Tiny Socks For Tiny Tots



**Bliss**  
for babies born  
premature or sick

### Materials:

**Yarn:** 25g double knit and contrast for trim (optional)

**Needles:** 3.75mm

### Abbreviations:

Inc1 = increase by knitting into the front and the back of the next stitch

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

S1 = Slip 1 stitch knitways

sts = stitches

### Instructions: (make two)

Cast on 26 sts

Row 1: K5, turn (work 2nd row on these 5 sts only)

Row 2: S1, K4

Row 3: K10, turn (work 4th row on these 10 sts only)

Row 4: S1, K9

Row 5: K26

Decrease for heel shaping:

Row 6: K7, K2tog, K1, K2tog, knit to end (24 sts)

Row 7: Knit

Row 8: K6, K2tog, K1, K2tog, knit to end (22 sts)

Row 9: Knit

Row 10: K5, K2tog, K1, K2tog, knit to end (20 sts)

Rows 11-24: Knit 14 rows without shaping

Increase for heel shaping:

Row 25: K12, Inc1, K1, Inc1, k5 (22 sts)

Row 26: Knit

Row 27: K13, Inc1, K1, Inc1, k6 (24 sts)

Row 28: Knit

Row 29: K14, Inc1, K1, Inc1, k7 (26 sts)

Row 30: Knit

Row 31: K10, turn (work 32nd row on these 10 sts only)

Row 32: S1, K9

Row 33: K5, turn (work 34th row on these 5 sts only)

Row 34: S1, K4

Row 35: Cast off

**Make up:**

With the right side facing, the left side (narrower end) will be the toe end of the sock.

Stitch the longer edges together with right side facing.

Run a length of wool through the toe end of the sock and pull tightly to gather stitches together.

Use blanket stitch to trim the edge of the sock if required.
