The GPA has invested a significant amount of money back into the school, with the Woodland Classroom (Coronation Cabin) being the biggest investment. The main fundraiser for the Coronation Cabin was the GPA Summer Ball 2022, where we raised a grand total of £10,292.10. So, financing the Coronation Cabin has been an ongoing effort over two years! We are also delighted to have supported the STEAM department with 3D printers and an educational LEGO set, both proving very popular with the children. The Sports Department is making good use of the Blaze Pots and Ball Feeders for Cricket practice. The Camera equipment is being used by various departments and is an useful tool for teachers and their documentation.

Our bookkeeping is looked after by our Treasurer, Beth, who will report all numbers to the Board of Governors.

Our amazing GPA Shop Ladies have also been working hard over the past 12 months and within the renovation plans of the school, the GPA Shop will be moving to its new premises during the summer holidays - Ready to open for the new school year in a nice new location at "Little Gayhurst". The entrance will be from Maltmans Lane (SL9 8RW). Please keep supporting our GPA Shop by donating preloved Gayhurst uniform items, which are in good condition (and clean) and shopping some of your child's uniform with us. We also have new stock of Gayhurst Merchandise, which we hope you will like as much as we do!

In addition, the GPA and all Year Group Reps have supported school at Open Days, helped out during the photo sessions (individual and class pictures), supporting various charitable causes, such as the Tribe Freedom Foundation, Toy Collection for local hospitals, Earthquake urgent appeal and the Harvest collection.
