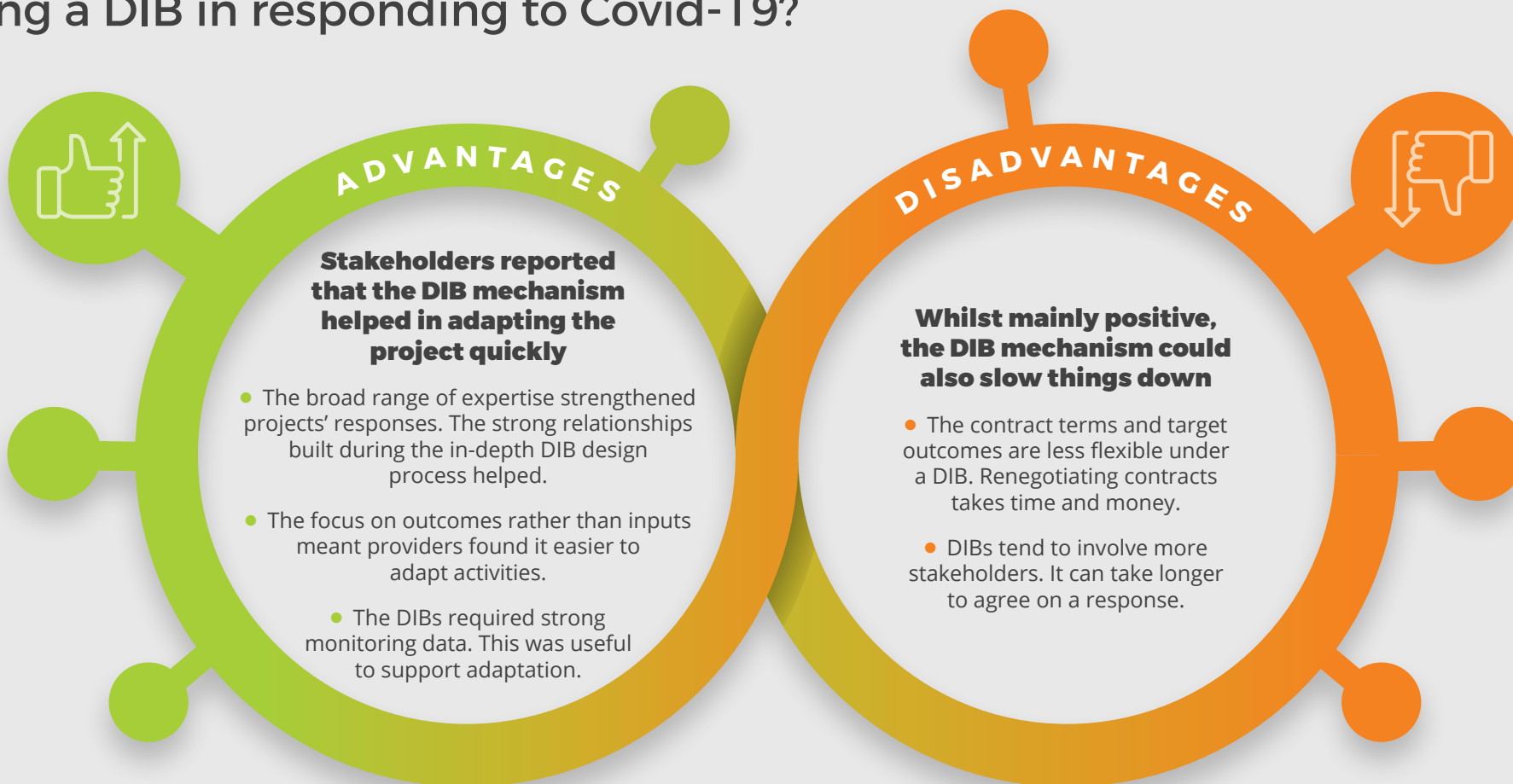


DIBs and Covid

What were the advantages and disadvantages of using a DIB in responding to Covid-19?



What are the lessons?

- 1 Changes do not always have to be through contract amendments, which can be expensive.
- 2 Build in processes into governance arrangements to agree changes. This means DIBs can respond faster in crises.
- 3 Maintaining a sharp focus on the outcomes when agreeing adaptations to programme delivery can help circumvent areas of disagreement between stakeholders and identify areas of compromise more easily.
