

Visitor Guidance

We hope you have an enjoyable and safe visit to Grocers' Hall.

Please take a few moments to read the guidance notes below which will help you to take the right action in the event of an emergency.

Fire Action	
Discovering a Fire	 If you discover a fire or smell smoke, raise the alarm by shouting fire and activating the nearest Manual Call Point (MCP). The fire alarm is to be raised whenever a fire is discovered, reported or suspected, irrespective of size. All alarm-operating points are sited on routes leading to safety. Operating the alarms - press the black spot on the alarm thus sounding the alarm. The fire alarm is a continuous bell ring. Evacuate immediately (do not use the lifts), closing doors on your way out. Once safely outside of the building await the arrival of the Fire and Rescue Services at the fire assembly point and report to the Building Incident Controller (BIC). The full address of the building is: Princes Street, London, EC2R 8AQ. (what3words ///chained.orange.forks).
On Hearing the Fire Alarm	 On hearing the alert signal, evacuate the building. Exit the building using your nearest means of escape by following the Fire Exit signage. All fire exits are clearly indicated with green running man signs. Close doors and windows on your way out, if it is SAFE to do so. Do not use lifts, stop to collect personal belongings, carry drinks, or use mobile phones. Do not re-enter the building until advised it is safe to do so by a member of the London Fire Brigade. The London Fire Brigade will be alerted by an automatic alarm system. The fire alarm is tested routinely at 09:00hrs on a Wednesday unless there is an event taking place. NOTE - If you find an escape route blocked and you cannot clear it yourself, ensure you report this to the Compliance Manager on 07906 438297.
The three Fire Exits and the route to the Fire Assembly Point for Grocers' Hall are shown below:

Accessibility

- If you have any accessibility requirements, please speak to your event organiser for them to notify our • events team.
- Fully accessible washrooms and disabled toilets are located on the basement floor.
- If in an emergency you would need assistance getting out of the building please speak to your event or meeting organiser or host about a Personal Emergency and Evacuation Plan (PEEP).

First Aid

- First Aid facilities are primarily located near Reception. Here you will find first aid supplies, a defibrillator, evacuation chair, stretcher, blankets and emergency first aid crash bag.
- Contact Reception on **020 7606 3113** if you require First Aid support.
- First Aid boxes can be found on every floor as follows:
 - Basement Silver room with eye wash station.
 - Basement Cloakroom and Boiler room corridor with eye wash station.
 - First Floor Main kitchen with 'burns' kit.
 - Mezzanine Staff Kitchen. 0
 - Second Floor Kitchen.
 - Third Floor Valet's room with eye wash station.
 - Fourth Floor Office kitchen. 0
- If you need emergency medical assistance, phone 999.
