

Covid-19 Classes and Workshop

Following the announcement from the Government on 15th October 2020 that London will move into Tier 2 restrictions from Saturday 17th October, Harrow Arts Centre continues to operate as a COVID secure venue.

As such the following exemptions apply to classes, workshops and activities that operate from Harrow Arts Centre where people from different households can gather beyond the limits set:

- for work, volunteering to provide voluntary or charitable services
- for registered education or training
- for supervised activities provided for children, including youth groups and activities, and children's playgroups
- for outdoor exercise and dance classes, organised outdoor sport, and licensed outdoor physical activity
- indoor organised team sports for disabled people, and youth sport

Other activities, such as indoor exercise classes and other activity groups can only continue provided that households or support bubbles do not mix.

If your activity/class is not included in the above exemptions and you cannot ensure that households or support bubbles do not mix during the session then we would ask you that you cancel your classes by close of play Monday 19th October as we will suspend our cancellation charges until this time.

What if I need to cancel my classes?

- If you require to cancel your classes due to this recent Government update, then you can do so with no cancellation fees up until 5pm on Monday 19th October. If you request to cancel your classes after the 19th October then our usual cancellation charges will apply.

What do we need from you?

- Please email box.office@harrowarts.com if you have any questions about your booking or if you wish to cancel due to the latest Government rules.
- You have until the 19th October to request a cancellation with no cancellation charges. A request after the 19th October will result in our usual cancellation charges applying.
- Ensure that customers are keeping to the social distancing and household restrictions during your classes or workshops.
- Rooms will be opened 15 minutes prior to your booking – please ask your students to stagger their arrival prior to the class within these 15 minutes.
- Abide by the new set capacities – they are there for the safety of everyone.
- ‘Track and Trace’ - we will require you to keep a dated register of your classes with customers names and phone numbers (so that they are able to be contacted should an outbreak occur). There are also NHS Track and Trace QR code posters available across the site for customers to use.
- Anti-bac wipes and hand sanitiser will be provided at the start of each class or workshop for use and will be collected at the end by our Facilities team. Please keep these safe as we don’t want them wandering off.
