Hotel participate in Bangkok Clean Up River: Clean Up the World is a community based environmental campaign that inspires and empowers communities from every corner of the globe to clean up, fix up, and conserve their environment.

For Bangkok Clean Up River, partner hotels and venues work with Bangkok Metropolitan Administration, Eco-Capitals Forum (comprised of foreign embassies in Bangkok), local businesses, community groups, and their neighbours to remove rubbish from streets, public spaces, and canals that might feed them into the Chao Phraya River and onto the beaches in the Gulf of Thailand.

Activity for guest (team building activity):

Build A Bicycle: The group will be divided into teams and each team will be tasked to complete a series of games in a competition against other teams. After each game, teams receive parts of a bike which they bring along with them to the second part of the activity; building their team's bike. At the end of the day the bikes are donated to the children of the charity in a surprise ceremony with everyone involved.
