



Using the Screener


This is a guide to the Integrum ESG screening tool - which can be found in the left hand sidebar menu.




You can use the screening tool in any profile; so when a set of scores are returned, those scores will reflect the customisations set within that profile. You can screen the company universe using broad criteria, or a set of very specific criteria.



Each 'field' is a search criterion, whether it is a specific country, a sector, or ESG metric




Let us imagine we wanted to screen for US companies where the Governance score has deteriorated, year-on-year.




That screen has only 2 criteria.


Firstly, the country. We select the US.




The second criterion is the Governance score, incorporated using the 'AND' button.



We can screen by absolute scores, or the year-on-year change in score.




We then need to set the threshold for the amount of year-on-year change. Then just click the 'Run Query' button in order to generate the screen.




The output is generated almost instantly. You can filter the results by any of the column headings.




So - we are now looking at US companies where the Governance score has weakened, in descending order of year-on-year deterioration. You can export this screen to Excel if you like, with just one click.



If you wanted, you could then focus in on just one particular subsector by incorporating this via the 'AND' button and following the drop downs.





You can then clear all fields and start again.
