



# GUIDE TO YEAR 6 HOSPITAL ATTACHMENTS



In Year 6, students focus on consolidating their clinical knowledge and skills, while becoming increasingly involved in patient care as a member of the clinical team

Students are expected to immerse themselves in the activities of the clinical environment

Clinical placements should provide an environment for students to build on the fundamentals of teamwork, communication, history taking and examination while also acquiring basic procedural skill competencies

A successful placement is likely to be facilitated by:

- 1. Students feeling welcomed – orientation, greeting, being included in daily working practice
- 2. Students feeling valuable – inter-disciplinary work, patient interactions, procedural skills
