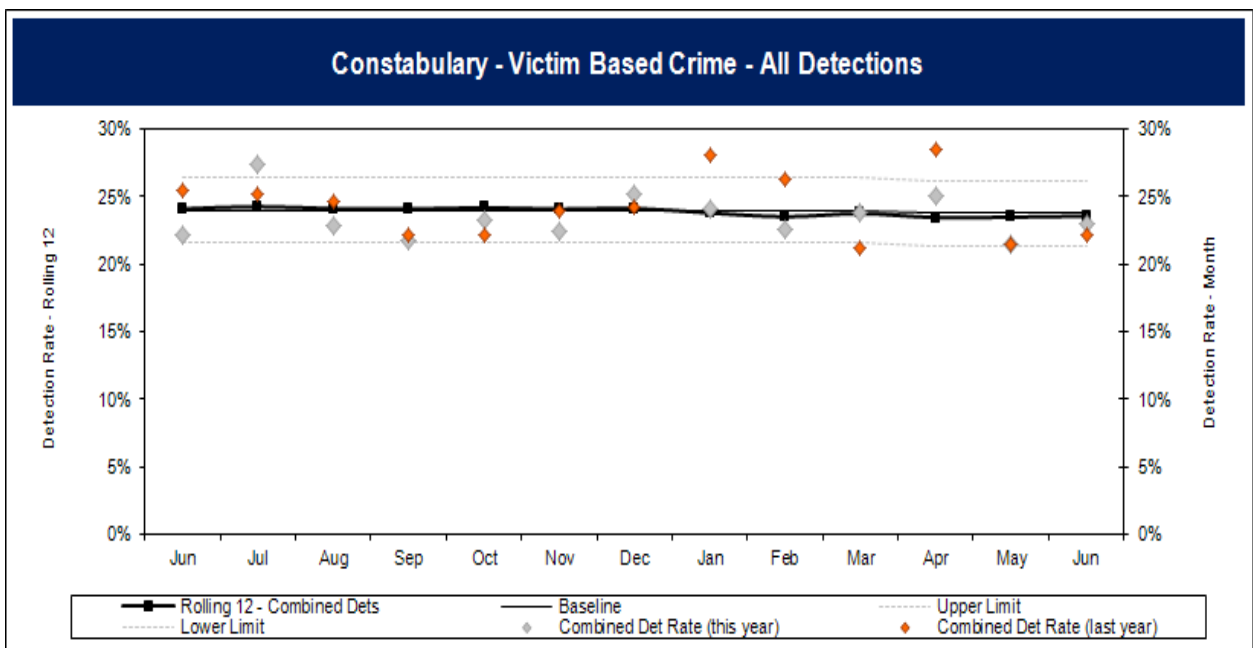
All Crime Detection Rate				



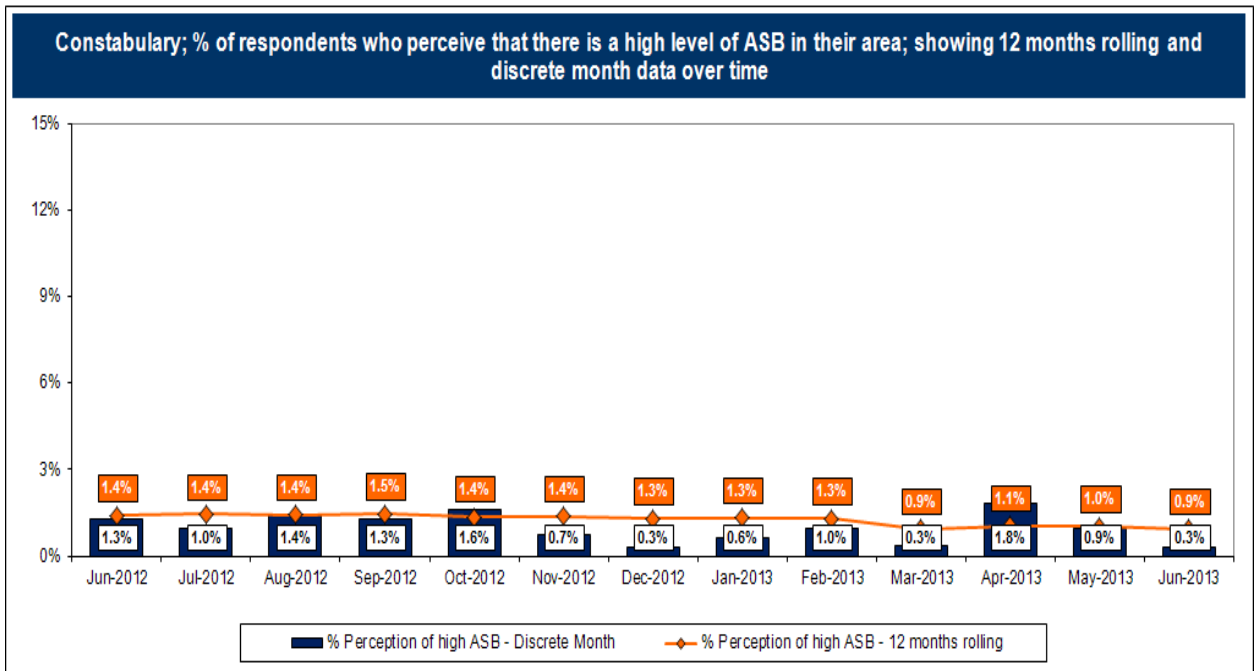

Burglary Dwelling Detection Rate			



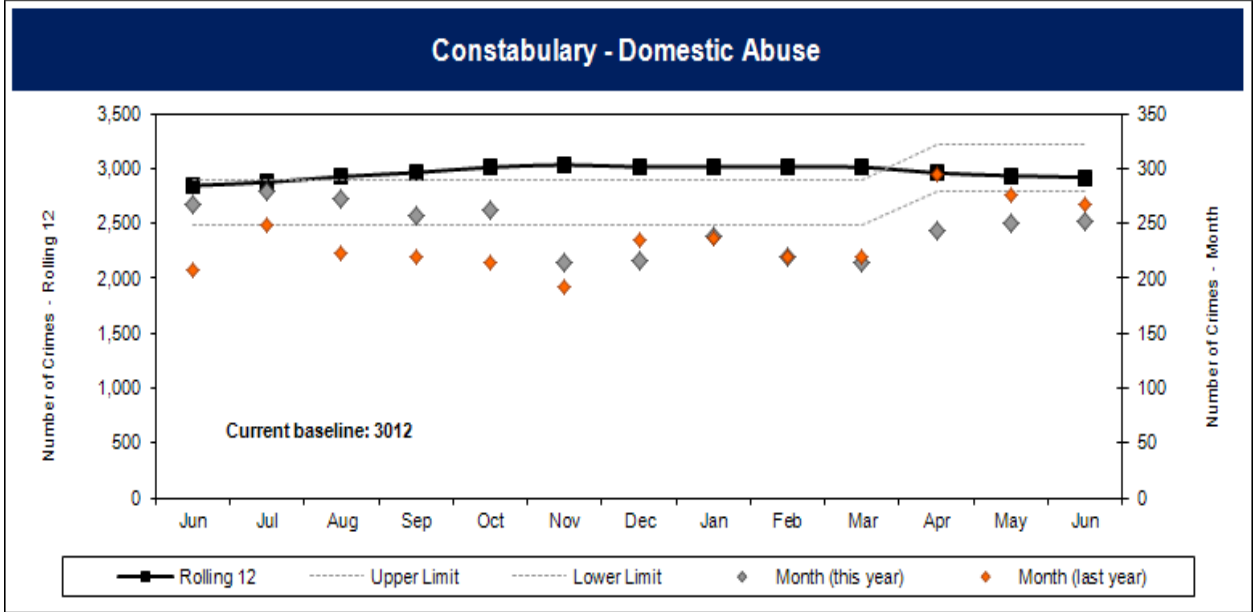

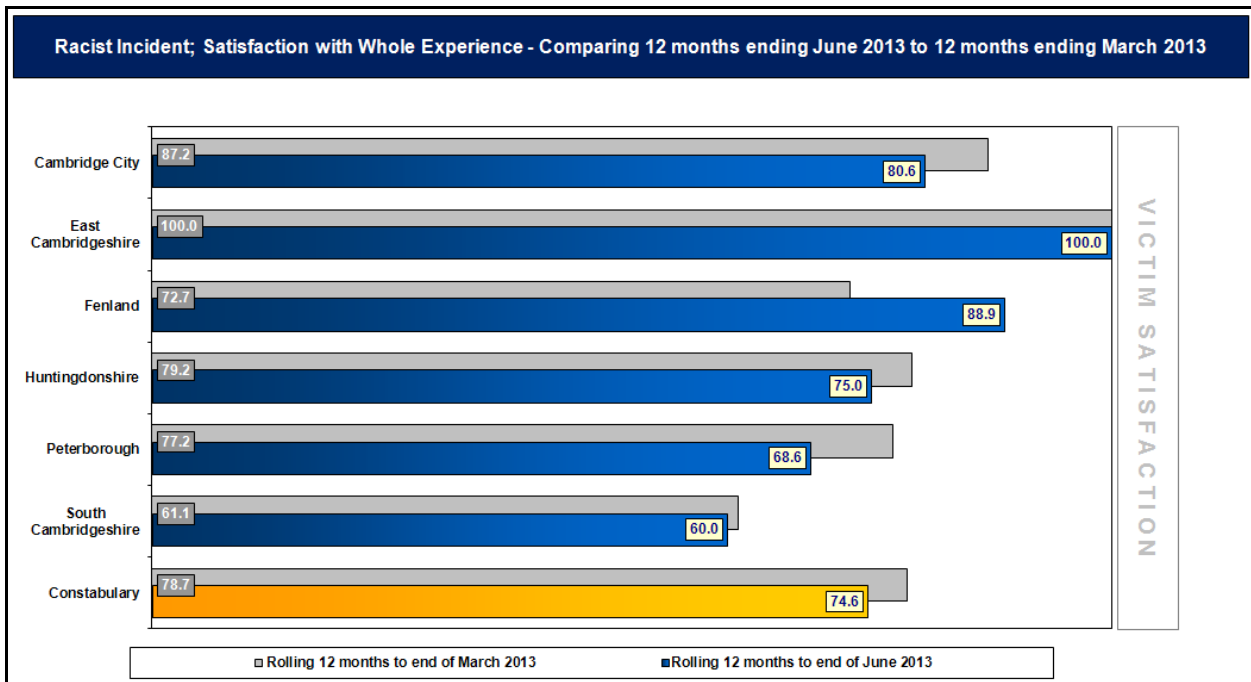




Hate Crime Detection Rate



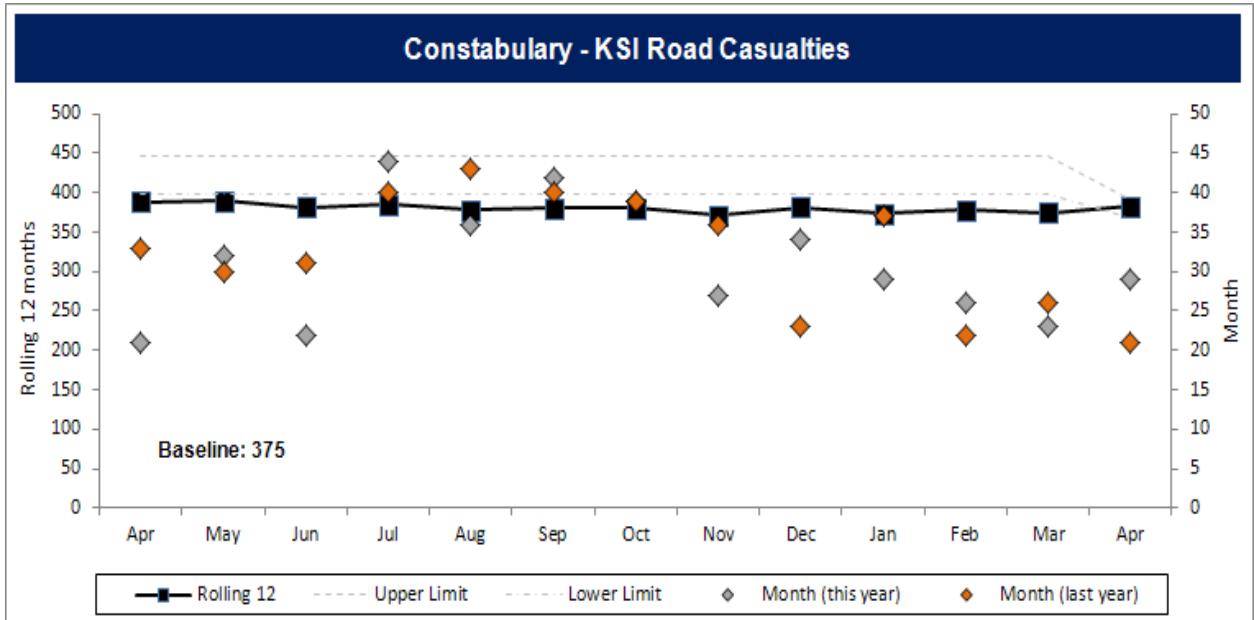
