## **DECISIONS BY CAMBRIDGESHIRE POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER**

### **1. Purpose**

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform the Business Coordination Board (“the Board”) of the decisions made by the Police and Crime Commissioner (“the Commissioner”) since the last Board meeting on the 13<sup>th</sup> November 2014 and those taken since that meeting. The report also provides an indication as to the decisions that it is anticipated the Commissioner will take at the Board meeting on the 17<sup>th</sup> December 2014 and those that are anticipated to be taken imminently.

### **2. Recommendation**

### **3. Background**

3.1 The Commissioner’s Decision Making Policy establishes the parameters, approach and principles for decision making, the process for decision making and the recording and publication of any decisions made by the Commissioner.

3.2 The Commissioner has a statutory duty under the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Specified Information) Order 2011 and the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Specified Information) (Amendment) Order 2012 to publish documents and information. This includes a record of every significant decision taken by or on behalf of the Commissioner as a result of a meeting or otherwise. All the decisions made by the Commissioner are published on his website, thus discharging the duty to publish.

3.3 In accordance with section 28 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, the Cambridgeshire Police and Crime Panel (“the Panel”) is able to review or scrutinise decisions made by the Commissioner. The Commissioner duly notifies the Panel of the decisions he has made.
