DECISIONS BY CAMBRIDGESHIRE POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER

1. Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform the Business Coordination Board (“the Board”) of the decisions made by the Police and Crime Commissioner (“the Commissioner”) since the Board meeting on the 29th April 2015 and the decisions taken since that meeting. The report also provides an indication as to the decisions presented to the Commissioner that he will consider at the Board meeting on the 4th June 2015 and those that are anticipated to be considered imminently thereafter.

2. Recommendation

2.1 The Board is asked to note these decisions as given at Appendix 1.

3. Background

3.1 The Commissioner’s Decision Making Policy establishes the parameters, approach and principles for decision making, the process for decision making and the recording and publication of any decisions made by the Commissioner.

3.2 The Commissioner has a statutory duty under the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Specified Information) Order 2011 and the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Specified Information) (Amendment) Order 2012 to publish documents and information. This includes a record of every significant decision taken by, or on behalf of, the Commissioner as a result of a meeting or otherwise. All the decisions made by the Commissioner are published on his website, thus discharging the duty to publish.

3.3 In accordance with section 28 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, the Cambridgeshire Police and Crime Panel (“the Panel”) is able to review or scrutinise decisions made by the Commissioner. The Commissioner duly notifies the Panel of the decisions he has made.

4. Recommendation

4.1 The Board is asked to note these decisions as given at Appendix 1.
