
Subject	Nomination of appointment of Chairs for Police Misconduct Hearings																				
Decision	Approve the 17 nominations of appointment for Chairs of Police Misconduct Hearings under The Police (Conduct) Regulations 2012 (as amended) and for Cambridgeshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner to maintain the list of Chairs on behalf of the Eastern Region Police and Crime Commissioners																				
Decision Summary	<p>The Police (Conduct) Regulations 2012 (amended by Police (Conduct) (Amendment) Regulations 2015 (“the Regulations”)) brings more transparency, independence and justice to the police disciplinary system.</p> <p>The Regulations provide that from the 1st January 2016, Police Misconduct Hearings will be conducted by a Chair, a member of a police force of at least the rank of superintendent and an Independent Member.</p> <p>Under the Regulations, Police and Crime Commissioners are responsible for nominating Chairs and thereafter for maintaining and administering the list of the Chairs.
