Cambridgeshire Constabulary	Gladstone Street Soccer provides football games and coaching to around 30-50 young people for 90 minutes every week, supported by Cambridgeshire Constabulary and FA coaches.	£2,500
KICK Youth	To pilot a youth club in St Ives for young people aged 11-14 years old once a week for two hours for a year.	£3,000
Wisbech Cadets	Ten cadets to go on a weekend sailing trip to learn team building and leadership skills as well as bonding as a group.	£1,000
