Section 50 Licences for Cambridgeshire ANPR camera installations

1. Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this report is to update the Business Coordination Board (“the Board”) and request the Police and Crime Commissioner’s (“the Commissioner”) signature for section 50 permits to allow installation of Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) cameras on Highway infra structures.

2. Recommendation

2.1 The Commissioner is recommended to sign the permits for ANPR installations for Cambridge and Peterborough City councils.

3. Background

3.1 Cambridgeshire Constabulary has a three year business plan in place for the installation of ANPR cameras at strategically identified locations. The final phase of this business plan covers the installation of twenty four cameras on the strategic road network (trunk roads). Cambridge and Peterborough City councils require section 50 permits to be agreed and signed to allow for installations to take place on highway lamp columns and infrastructure. This sets out that Cambridgeshire Constabulary accepts ownership and any the risk of the camera at the locations specified. This is not something that has been requested previously with other installation or in Bedfordshire or Hertfordshire but it is part of daily ownership, management and risk that forces have with regard to camera installations. The funding for the permits has been authorised.

4. Recommendation

- 4.1 The Commissioner is recommended to sign the permits for ANPR installations for Cambridge and Peterborough City councils.
