**Shared Outcome:** Offenders are brought to justice and are less likely to reoffend

<b>2019/20 priorities for action</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develop integrated one team approach to disrupt offenders.</li> <li>• Implement targeted Days of Action.</li> <li>• Exploit civil powers and new legislation to restrict offenders &amp; reduce harm (ie CAWNs and see victims section and use of SHPOs and DVPOs)</li> <li>• Strengthen local partnership disruption activity ie immigration/GLAA/HMRC</li> <li>• Target asset recovery</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reduce the number of first time entrants to the Criminal Justice System.</li> <li>• Improve the quality of police investigations and police files for prosecution.</li> <li>• Further progress collaborative working between CPS/Police by exploring opportunities to co-locate within the police estate.</li> <li>• Ensure there is in place consistent and robust processes to trace offenders and bring them to justice.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develop &amp; highlight the work of Safer Schools Partnership.</li> <li>• Review and refresh Integrated Offender Management arrangements.</li> <li>• Continue to work with partners to offer appropriate Out of Court Disposals which address the causes of criminality.</li> <li>• Ensure partnership approach with probation to prevent hate crime re-offending</li> <li>• Embed a culture of sharing best practice across agencies</li> <li>• Ensuring work with academic networks to provide a sound evidence based approach</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Co-ordinate partners' activity against highest threat &amp; harm offenders ie County Lines/CSE/gang members/DA perpetrators</li> <li>• Ensure effective partnership approach to tackling serious street based violence</li> <li>• Ensure effective &amp; efficient partnership work around MAPPA nominals.</li> <li>• Consider response to roll-out of national electronic monitoring programme.</li> <li>• Ensure partnership approach to prevent hate crime re-offending</li> </ul>
<b>Broader partnership support</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide support for Partnership Offender Cohorts/Schemes such as IOM/CHI/DV Perpetrator Panel.</li> <li>• Improve desistance pathways to ensure resilience of services and effective and efficient action to address the causes of offending. This includes focus on accommodation, education, employment &amp; training, health, drugs &amp; alcohol, female offenders and domestic violence.</li> <li>• Support national drive to strengthen NPS/CRC.</li> <li>• Develop effectiveness of CJB &amp; CCCSSB Boards.</li> </ul>
