On 18 January 2019 you requested the following information:

Under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act could you please:

- (a) Provide a copy of any policy, instructions, advice or standing orders relating to the supply of information to the Department of Work and Pensions relating to disabled people taking part in protests;
- (b) In the event that you have referred any such information to the Department of Work and Pensions, state how many individuals this related to, and over what period of time you have been collecting such information; and
- (c) In the event that you rely upon any exemptions in relation to (a) or (b) state whether such documentation exists.

I can advise that the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does not hold the information requested. However, Cambridgeshire Constabulary, which is a separate organisation and is treated as such under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, may hold this information.
