Hi Member of the Public

The Commissioner has passed on your email for me to respond on his behalf.

I am writing in response to your correction request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, dated 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2018.

You requested the following information:

- The number of reported complaints/crimes relating to Islamophobia in Peterborough, broken down for the years 2016, 2017, and 2018.
- The number of arrests made in relation to complaints of Islamophobia in Peterborough during the same time frame.
- The number of hate crimes reported during those years.
- The number of complaints/accusations of electoral fraud made by members of the public during those years.
- The number of investigations carried out in relation to suspected electoral fraud during the past 3 years, and the number of arrests made.

I can advise you that the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does not hold the information requested. However, Cambridgeshire Constabulary, which is a separate organisation and is treated as such under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, hold this information.
