Dear Member of the Public

I am writing in response to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, dated 22nd February.

You requested information regarding commissioned services for survivors of domestic violence and abuse.

We do not commission Domestic Violence and Abuse services as these are commissioned in Cambridgeshire by the Local Authorities (Cambridgeshire County Council and Peterborough City Council) and the third sector.

In Cambridgeshire, we have an integrated model of support for victims and witnesses of crime. The Victim and Witness Hub provides support to all victims and witnesses – victims of DA (standard and medium risk) are provided with telephone based emotional and practical support and this is part of a wider (partnership) contract.

We fund a Young Person's IDVA (£40k) in Cambridgeshire County Council granted as part of their commissioned model of support services for victims of DA.

We trust that the information provided above meets your needs. However, if you are unhappy with this response, please see below 'satisfied with our service', which sets out your rights to appeal.
