

Dear Member of the Public

I am writing in response to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, dated 17<sup>th</sup> August.

You requested information about Drug and Alcohol Services. I will respond to each question in turn:

A) The total budget for drug and alcohol services in each of the financial years 2011/12, 2012/13, 2013/14, 2014/15, 2015/16, 2016/17 and 2017/18.

Prior to this grants were made directly by the Constabulary and the PCC does not hold this information. **Cambridgeshire £94,000**

**Peterborough £140,000**

i) The number of full time equivalent (FTE) drug and alcohol service staff employed.

ii) The total funding support provided to drug and alcohol service provision by the voluntary and community sector (VCS) and how many FTE staff this supports.

#### **Cambridgeshire**
