Dear Member of the Public

I am writing in response to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, dated 17th October. You requested information regarding custody suites, namely:

- 1) Broken down per year, how many custody suites have been closed between 2007 and the present day?
- 2) How many cells were lost as a consequence?
- 3) How many custody suites, if any, are expected to close in the next 2 years?
- 4) Broken down per year, how many custody sergeants have been employed each year between 2007 and the present day?
- 5) Broken down per year, how many detainees have been processed each year between 2007 and the present day?

I can advise that the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does not hold the information requested. However, Cambridgeshire Constabulary, which is a separate organisation and is treated as such under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, holds this information.
