Dear Member of the public

I am writing in response to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, dated 5th October.

You requested information regarding drug driving in Cambridgeshire. In particular:

- Please could you tell me how many drug wipe tests have been carried out in Cambridgeshire since March 2015 and how many of these have been positive? I would like the information broken down by month, up until the most recent month which has been fully recorded. If possible, I would like the figure for cannabis and cocaine separately.

I can advise that the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does not hold the information requested. However, Cambridgeshire Constabulary, which is a separate organisation and is treated as such under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, hold this information. You may wish to resubmit your request to them by email to foi@cambs.pnn.police.uk.
