Please refer to the briefing note below.</p> <p>The Police and Crime Commissioner should sign the amended Section 22A Agreement under the Police Act 1996 (as amended) for Cambridgeshire Constabulary to agree to the updated Sec 22A agreement for the collaborated Joint Protective Services function with Bedfordshire Police and Hertfordshire Constabulary.</p>
