## **VIEWS FROM THE PUBLIC RAISED WITH THE ACTING POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER**

### **1. Purpose**

- 1.1 This report is a standing agenda item to the Business Co-ordination Board (the “Board”). The usual purpose of this report is to enable the Acting Police and Crime Commissioner (the “Acting Commissioner”), in line with his remit, to listen to questions, issues and concerns of the public and communities, and in providing this local link between them and Cambridgeshire Constabulary (the “Constabulary”), bring these to the attention of the Chief Constable for him to respond to, given the operational nature of the questions.
- 1.2 However, the report to this meeting is to ask the Board to note that a full report on the concerns and questions raised by the public following the Acting Commissioner’s recent public survey regarding the precept will be submitted to the March 2021 Board meeting.
- 1.3 The survey generated a number of comments from members of the public in response to questions about feelings of safety and views on what they see as policing and crime issues of priority. A full analysis of these responses is being prepared which will then be included in this standing item report for discussion by the Board.
