Frequently Asked Questions – Gospel Revisited Concert

Question	Answer
When is the Gospel Revisited Concert happening?	Sunday 10th December Performances at 11am & 2pm
How much are tickets?	£58 per adult (taken down to £40 for members at checkout) and £15 per child
Where is the concert?	This will take place inside the Adam Hall which you enter via the main Mansion House entrance. It has flat access
How long will the Concert last?	The concert is expected to last approx. 1 hour and your hot drink and nibble will be served after
Food – what will be on offer?	Our restaurant will be open, offering delicious seasonal treats and warming hot drinks throughout our festive season including a hot chocolate making station! Roast dinners in our restaurant and 2 or 3 course Christmas dinners in Adam Hall from our partner caterers Fosters, can be booked on selected dates from 7th – 24th December via our online or telephone booking system
Are there seating allocations?	Seating in the venue is not allocated, choice of seat is dependent on time of arrival
Where do we park?	Our car park will be open as normal and the shuttle bus will run between the visitors centre and main house throughout the day and events
Will the shuttle be running?	Yes, the shuttle will run between the visitors centre and the house throughout the events
Can I bring my dog?	Well-behaved dogs are welcome around our grounds however we only allow guidance dogs inside the house and we would ask that visitors are mindful of other guests and keep their dogs on a short lead at all times. We have a dog walkers code of conduct on our website which we'd ask that people read and follow
