About the RSC Associate Schools Programme

Our Associate Schools Programme with the Royal Shakespeare Company is targeted towards schools who want to develop and improve access to Shakespeare and deliver the best in classroom teaching through active drama techniques.

For students, the programme involves dynamic ways to learn about Shakespeare, artist-led projects, and performance opportunities on our stage, in our local community and at the RSC in Stratford-Upon-Avon. For teachers, the programme involves a continued professional development regime, where we discuss and learn how to break down the language and themes of Shakespeare's work, how to perform works of Shakespeare, and other techniques on how to work as ensemble, performance enhancing activities and workshops, and confidence building.

Every year, we invite 12 schools to apply for a place on this 24 month programme which include performance opportunities, RSC practitioner workshops, director and choreographer support and a support network of teachers who exchange ideas and share best practice throughout the programme. This is led and coordinated with our Lead Associate School, Treviglas Academy.
