ENERGY POLICY STATEMENT

James cropper plc is a manufacturer of speciality coloured paper and board products, non-woven fabrics and the design, manufacture and supply of coloured thermoformed pulp products. The following statements summarise the Group's position regarding the management of its use of energy throughout its operations.

- a) We recognise that our operations are energy-intensive in nature, form a key constituent of our business, and therefore require careful management to minimise the use of energy resources
- b) The Company shall, through the application of suitable procedures and management activity, manage a continual improvement cycle (Plan, Do, Check, Act) in regard to its use of energy in its various forms; from its arrival at site, to conversion, through to consumption. Central to this is maintaining the Company's certification to the Energy Management Standard, ISO 50001: 2011
- c) The Company shall ensure the availability of information regarding its use of energy and the necessary resources to achieve its objectives and targets
- d) The Company shall maintain up-to-date knowledge of its legal and other requirements pertaining to its energy use, consumption and efficiency and shall comply with those requirements
- e) The Company shall, through its management processes, provide and maintain the framework for setting and reviewing energy objectives and targets
- f) The Company shall initiate and maintain procedures to implement the purchase of energy-efficient products and services, and design for energy performance improvement
- g) This Policy is documented and promulgated by the Company's senior management. By means of various internal media, the Company communicates this policy at all levels within the organisation and to interested parties via its website
- h) This policy is regularly reviewed, annually, according to set procedure, and updated as necessary
