
Reading into Writing

Science Practicals

Explores the benefits of practical work and suggests ways of using practicals to help students put learning into context and prepare for assessments.



Study Skills

Guidance on helping students to develop vital study skills and become active learners.



Teaching the Class Novel

Ideas and activities for teaching the class novel including developing reading skills, using drama and writing exercises.



Teaching Shakespeare

Supports English teachers in developing a repertoire of teaching strategies to apply to any of Shakespeare's plays.



Secondary History

An introduction to secondary school history, including discussion on conceptualising, structuring and teaching history.



Supporting EAL Learners

Outlining the challenges EAL learners face at school and what teachers, carers and other students can do to help them succeed.



Teaching Creative Writing

Helping teachers to enhance pupils' creative writing skills.



The EYFS Framework

A course introducing the Early Years Foundation Stage Framework.

Attachment

Covering the history of attachment theory and its role in relationships and professional practice, with practical advice.



Learning Needs

Covering learning needs such as Gifted & Talented, learning difficulties, and behavioural and communication needs.



Social Needs

Covering a range of social and wellbeing issues, including staying safe, friendships, relationships and resilience.



Understanding ADHD

This short course introduces teachers to ADHD and the challenges faced by pupils with ADHD.



Beat Bullying

Helping staff understand bullying, plus practical anti-bullying strategies and resources to use with pupils to discuss bullying.



Medical Conditions
