Mentor Engagement

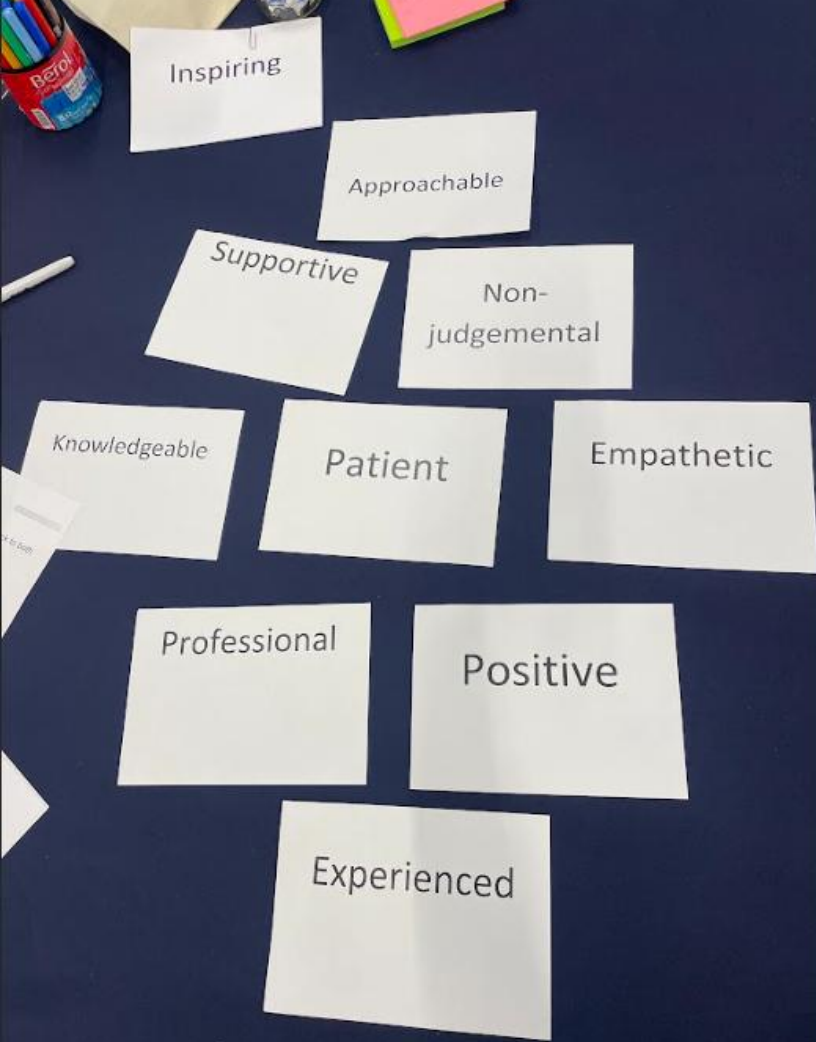

Attendance: June 93%, Sept 94%, Jan 87%

Completion of required hours:

20+ hours = 68% 18+ hours = 82% 15+ hours = 90%

Certification:

- **43 mentors received mentor recognition certificates**
- **23 mentors received mentor excellence (completed more than 20 hours)**
- **99% of mentors who trained and mentored a trainee were certificated**
