Upcoming Heritage Workshops: CABINET RESTORATION (voluntary positions)

Share your skills and time, give back, and meet like-minded people.



Union Chapel have some a Victorian and old cupboards that we need to restore to use within our future community hub space for all to enjoy.

We're recruiting volunteers to help us whilst learning more about how to lovingly and safely restore wooden antiques and furniture, with no previous carpentry or restoration experience necessary – just a thirst for learning!

There are two opportunities to take part:

<u>VICTORIAN CABINET RESTORATION</u>: Thursday 9 & Friday 10 May 9.30am to 5.30pm; 2 places available and must be able to attend both days. Application Deadline 2 May, 12pm.

Learn about the deterioration of wood, types of furniture joins, coatings, binding material, adhesives, consolidants, tools, protective equipment, and techniques and get hands-on restoring this full sized, multi-door Victorian cabinet.

<u>PAINTED CUPBOARD RESTORATION</u>: Thursday 16 & Friday 17 May 9.30am to 5.30pm; 2 places available and must be able to attend both days. Application Deadline 10 May, 12pm.

These two smaller cabinets are not pictured above, but do need some love! Learn about different wood surfaces, finishes, brushes, and tools, how to use solvents and coatings safely, and be mentored on restoration techniques of wood, locks, and hinges.

All materials and mentoring will be provided as well as lunch and a certificate of participation. Apply for one or both of these workshops you're interested in volunteering for with;

- a brief description of your skills and interest in heritage and community
- days you can attend
- any food allergies or dietary requirements (for lunch) or chemical allergies (for materials used in session)
- CV or short video is not mandatory but feel free to send if you like!


