Message from MIE Pathways





It develops students' subject knowledge, study skills and English language competency to a level suitable for smooth progression to undergraduate study.

NCUK universities recognise the programme as meeting their entry requirements for international students, with progression contingent on students satisfying the performance criteria.

INTERNATIONAL YEAR ONE (IYONE)

The NCUK International Year One in Business (IYOne Business) programme is a first-year undergraduate equivalent programme that builds students' knowledge and skills in the Business field.

It prepares and qualifies international students for entry to the second year (FHEQ Level 51) of appropriate undergraduate degree courses offered by NCUK Universities. Provided that the student has obtained the results mentioned by the pathway partner university.

NCUK Universities recognise the programme as meeting their entry requirements for international students, with progression contingent on students satisfying the performance criteria.




