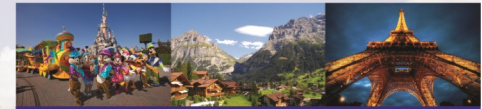

Nelson College London work with Inspire to provide work experience placements for local secondary and college students.

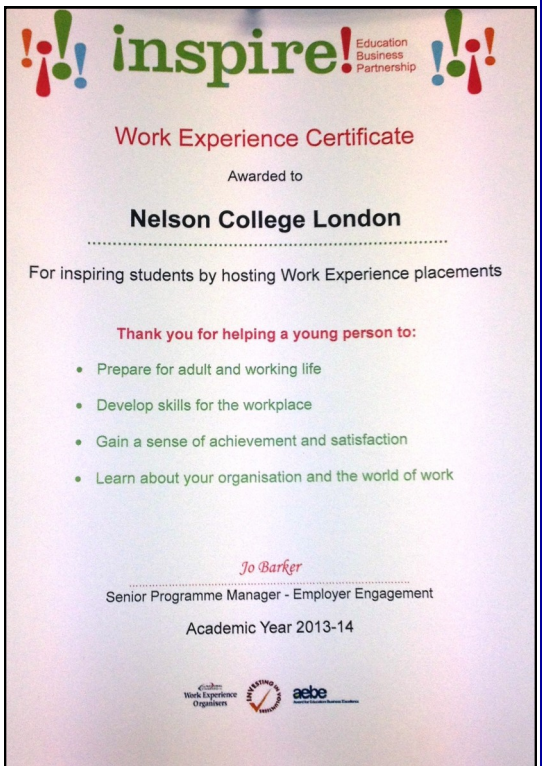

Learn about organisations and the world of work.



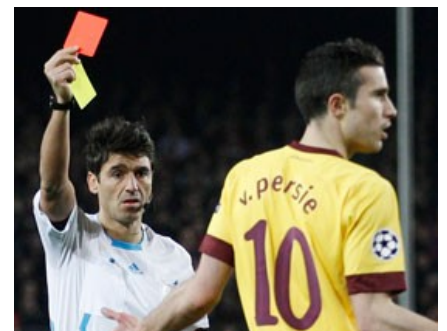
Student Code of Conduct

8. Behave professionally

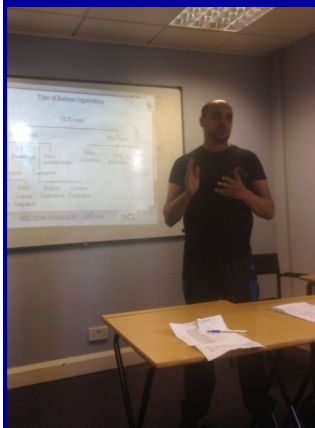


Disciplinary actions if Reported

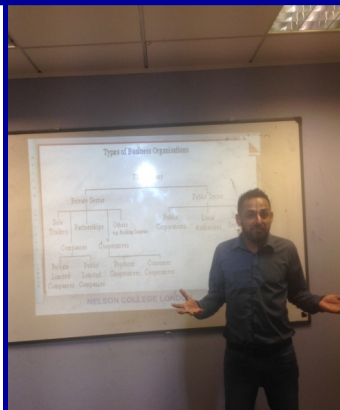
Jazz Dubb
