Frequency	Meetings / teleconferences shall be held monthly or every two months, as determined by the Steering Group.

	Agree and monitor the budget for the audit
	Appoint a Project Director
	Develop and agree the structure and content of the audit
	Develop and agree the format of the web-based audit tool and underlying databases
	Oversee the data collection and analysis phases of the project
	Review and authorise the publication of all audit outputs
	Agree a timetable for the audit and ensure the audit is delivered to published timescales
	Ensure appropriate records are maintained of organisations registered for the audit
	Ensure project financial records are maintained and regularly review the project financial position to ensure the project is within budget
