

## Eligibility for ECO Grants

If you can tick *any* of the blue boxes below, you are eligible.

Our total household income is less than £30,000 and we can tick one of the following boxes:

Our house has an Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) that is grade D or below

A member of our household has a health condition affected by being in a cold home

\*NB – Household income defined as income after tax, housing costs and energy costs are deducted. To calculate this, use your take home pay and deduct rent or mortgage costs and annual energy costs.

If you do not have an EPC you do not need to get this, we can estimate the grade. Your home might be higher than grade D if you have the walls and loft fully insulated and an efficient condensing boiler with a thermostat. If not, you will probably be eligible.

Common health conditions that would qualify include cardiovascular conditions (high blood pressure, heart disease/attacks, at risk of stroke), respiratory problems (Asthma, COPD), restricted mobility (arthritis, physical disability) or mental health (including depression or anxiety). This list is not exhaustive.

I receive a means tested benefit or tax credit.

This includes: Income based Job Seekers Allowance (JSA), Income related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA), Income Support, Pension Credit, Child Tax Credit, Working Tax Credit, Universal Credit

I receive a disability based benefit or tax credit.

This includes: Attendance Allowance, Constant Attendance Allowance, Carers Allowance, Disability Living Allowance, Industrial Injuries Disability Benefit, Personal Independence Payment, Severe Disablement Allowance, Armed Forces Independence Payment, War Pensions Mobility Supplement.

A resident of my house receives child benefit and our gross household income is equal to or lower than the following:
