

## **INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES**

Our websites may use cookies to distinguish you from other users of our websites. This helps us to seek to provide you with a good experience when you browse our websites and also allows us to seek to improve the use of our websites. By continuing to browse our websites, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer (if you agree that we may do so). Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use some or all of the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are required for the operation of our websites. They include, for example, cookies that may enable you to log into secure areas of our websites, or use certain functionality or services.
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to track how visitors move around our websites when they are using them. This helps us to improve the way our websites work, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our websites. They enable us to personalise our content for you and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our websites, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We use this information to make our websites and any content or advertising displayed on them more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

Please note that third parties (including, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies

You may block cookies by activating the relevant settings on your browser that allow you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all (or parts) of our websites.

Except for essential cookies, we will aim to ensure that our cookies will expire after a reasonable period of time.
