- Co-ordinate and lead on the delivery of the calendar of outputs and events for all three Monitor Farms in your Cluster
- Ensuring regular communications with your Monitor Farmers, the Programme Manager, and other Regional Advisers
- Facilitating programme meetings between operational members and stakeholders
- Develop and deliver communications from activity in your cluster using published content and social media
- Work as part of the wider team to compile and develop industry-leading materials for the wider industry
