COUNTRY PUB, BUNK BARN & CAMPSITE

IN LINE WITH THE GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES, WE HAVE HAD TO MAKE SOME MINOR CHANGES TO OUR SITE & FACILITIES IN ORDER TO PROTECT OUR CUSTOMERS & EMPLOYEES. PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE READ THE BELOW POINTS PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL AT THE ROYAL OAK, HURDLOW.

- On entry and exit to the toilet & shower blocks please ensure you use the hand sanitiser provided.
- Prior to using any of the facilities please use the antibacterial spray and wipes provided – you are responsible for your own sanitation.
- Our toilet and shower block facilities are open for use but are operating as usual – male & female. Please maintain social distancing when using all facilities. If there is visibly 2 people using the facilities, please wait outside until there is more space available.
- The doors to both the male & female facilities will be propped open at all times to increase air flow.
- For now, our bunk barn kitchen is closed for use, this is to protect customers and our cleaning staff. We assessed the risk and felt we could not minimise it to an acceptable level so have decided to eliminate risk altogether by closing these facilities. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by this, please understand we did not make this decision lightly.
- We have also increased the number and intensity of our cleans of the toilet & shower block facilities.
- We ask for all guests staying in our bunk barn to strip beds of all laundry and place in a pillowcase – this is for the safety of our cleaning staff and to minimise cross-contamination risks
- The Royal Oak is currently open and serving meals from 12-9pm Monday-Friday or from 8.30am-9pm Saturday & Sunday. Should you wish to book a table please do so on www.peakpub.co.uk or contact us on 01298 83288 or hello@peakpub.co.uk
- Due to current legislation, any table reservations that fall between 12th April – 16th May will be outside.
- Please observe social distancing rules at all times and keep 2 metres apart where possible. Where this cannot be achieved please ensure you keep at least 1 metre apart from anybody who is outside of your group
- Should we feel that anybody is in breach of any government legislation, including booking pitches/rooms under different names & congregating together over the relevant legal limit, we reserve the right to ask you to vacate the site or inform the local authority

12th April -
16th May

- Campsite open with increased cleaning of shared facilities
- Bunk barn closed for now
- Pub open for outside dining only - rule of 6 or 2 households applies
- Rule of 6 applies outdoor groups

17th May -
20th June

- Campsite & bunk barn open
- All facilities open (**not** bunk barn kitchen)
- Indoor dining - rule of 6 **or** 2 households
- Up to 6 people (from mixed households) **or** 7+ people from max 2 households per pitch/ bunk barn room
- Meeting outdoors - up to 30 people

21st June
Onwards

- Remaining restrictions set to be lifted
- No legal limit on socialising
- **If any changes to the government roadmap we will deal with each booking & enquiry individually**

IMPORTANT - Where the rule of 6 or 2 household limit applies in dining, we will not permit groups split over more than 1 table as we will still view your total numbers as a singular group. This is in line with the current legislation & for the protection of our employees & customers.
