It is not enough for the unions in the steel industry to clamour for the best redundancy deal possible.

Once the mills are closed, the jobs are gone, and the skills have become museum pieces then our future generations will have been betrayed and buried.

It is not enough for workers to sit at home and take their pittance in furloughed pay, fatalistically waiting for the closure to be finalised and the redundancy notice to arrive. Or hoping against hope that the government on a white horse will ride up to save them.

The strategy of government and employers is to break morale, undermine collective identity and strength, and corrode the class consciousness which as unified workers makes us strong.
