External Examinations

Yesterday we received communication from some Awarding Organisations confirming students may be able to sit their exam later this year and heard the announcement by Gavin Williamson Secretary of State for Education that students will receive a form of teacher assessed grade as opposed to a grade calculated by an algorithm. As a result, we have taken the decision to cancel all January exams from Monday 11th January, with the exception of a small number of critical exams next week. For the critical exams next week, we will contact the individual students this applies to in the next few days and offer them the opportunity to sit their exams.

We are committed to supporting all of our students to achieve the best possible outcomes and we will be working hard to ensure that students get a fair and accurate grade in the coming months and are not disadvantaged in any way. Students should continue to work hard and engage with online learning, this will help teachers assess your ability and prepare you for your next step, whether that is further study or employment.

As soon as we have more detailed information from Awarding Organisations we will be issuing further communications on the alternative assessment methods and how we will be supporting students to achieve the best grades possible.
