



## DIRECTIONS TO NEW COLLEGE STAMFORD

**BY RAIL:** Stamford has its own railway station – you can walk (15 mins) or get a taxi to the College. The nearest main line railway station is Peterborough, on the eastern coast main line running between London King's Cross and the north of Scotland.

**BY ROAD:** There is a visitor's car park outside the College's main Reception area.

**Approaching from the South-West (A43) and South (A1):** Into Stamford on High Street St. Martins, downhill past the George Hotel, cross over River Welland. Immediate right into Wharf Road. After Ford garage sharp bend to right onto St. Leonard's Street. Turn left into Brazenose Lane. Turn right at traffic lights into St. Pauls Street. Veer left at mini-roundabout into Ryhall Road. Continue past hospital (on right). Turn left into Drift Road. College is 300m on left.

**Approaching from the North (A1 then B1081 Casterton Road) and from the West (A606 Empingham Road):** Into town at Scotgate (BP garage on left). Turn left at cross roads into North Street. Continue into East Street. Turn left into Conduit Road. Continue into Emlyns Street. Turn right into Drift Road. College is 300m on right.

**Approaching from the North-East (A6121 Ryhall Road):** Turn right into Drift Road. College is 300m on left.

**Approaching from the East (A16 Uffington Road):** Go straight on at mini-roundabout (with Morrisons superstore on right). Continue to second mini-roundabout - turn right into Ryhall Road. Continue past hospital (on right) turn left into Drift Road. College is 300m on left.
