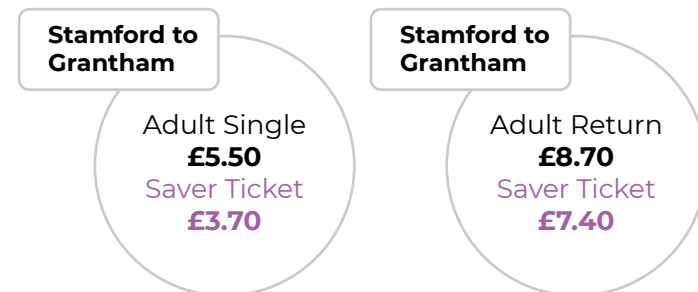

CallConnect Fares

Students are able to purchase Saver tickets (10 journeys) or a Single/Day Return ticket direct from the driver. Payment is accepted by cash or by card. HOW TO APPLY

After you have applied and been offered a place on a course, you will receive a link, ID and password by email to apply for your bus pass online.

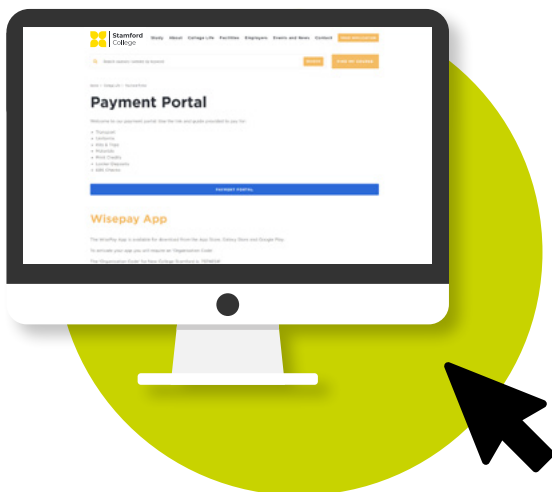
HOW TO PAY

Once you have enrolled, you can either pay in full or in 3 instalments (first instalment due before the first day of the academic year, or as soon as you receive your payment portal login information).

To pay online, visit: www.stamford.ac.uk under **College Life** select **Payment Portal** and log in.

Transport costs are based on average usage. A very limited number of students may be required to pay a top-up fee should they require additional transport, but we will inform you with plenty of notice if this affects you.

Financial Support may be available to assist with the costs of transport if your household income is below £25,000 per year. Once you have been offered a place on a course, you will receive more information on how to apply for Financial Support.



FAQs

My parents live on 2 different bus routes, do I need to purchase two bus passes?

Each situation is assessed on an individual basis; please contact the Transport team for more information: transport@stamford.ac.uk

Can I receive a temporary bus pass for one-time use?

Single trip temporary bus passes may be available for purchase depending on bus capacity at the time of the request. If you lose your bus pass you will be required to purchase a new pass at a cost of £5.

Am I entitled to a refund if I leave my course?

By applying and paying for a bus pass, you are signing up for a full academic year. If you leave your course before the Autumn Half Term a refund will be issued upon receipt of a written request for a refund and the return of the student bus pass. Requests for refunds should be sent to: financial.support@stamford.ac.uk

I'm learning to drive, what happens when I pass?

If you live on a designated home-to-college transport route it is expected that you will continue to use this mode of transport until the end of the academic year as the full cost will have been incurred by the College. If you are not able to access College transport services, and would like to use your car to travel to College, you must register your vehicle with the Transport team using our online application portal.

When will I receive my bus pass?

Bus passes will be issued upon receipt of full payment. You will be allowed to travel on the home-to-college transport using your ID badge, issued on your first day, until half term (21 October). After this date a valid bus pass will be required.
