- Stage 1: School are requested to have a short interview with the School Liaison & Admissions Manager to discuss circumstances around student.
- Stage 2: Students are invited to attend a College Experience Session and informal interview.
- Curriculum send offer to admissions with course code. School Liaison & Admissions
 Manager will then inform schools of offer. Schools should inform the student and parent/
 quardian.
- Student invited to enrolment day in July.
- Student fully enrolled onto course.
- September student starts.

- Application form is completed by school.
